



## • HOW TO CROCHET PECK THE PIGEON •



ARE YOU LOOKING FOR A NEW FRIEND? OR PERHAPS A COMFY LITTLE PILLOW? A WOOLY DOORSTOP?  
THEN WHY NOT CROCHET ONE!

### ABBREVIATIONS

ch	chain stitch
st	stitch
sc	single crochet
dc	double crochet
hdc	half double crochet
slip st	slip stitch

### COLORS

- > Blue-gray 50 g (color code 41)
- > Plus white (cc 19)
- > Pumpkin (cc 6)
- > Mustard yellow (cc 38)
- > Midnight blue (cc 18)

### MATERIAL

- > Lana Grossa Superlana  
(100% pure new wool / length 110 m / 50 g)

### OTHER STUFF:

- > No. 4 crochet hook
- > 2 eye buttons
- > Stuffing

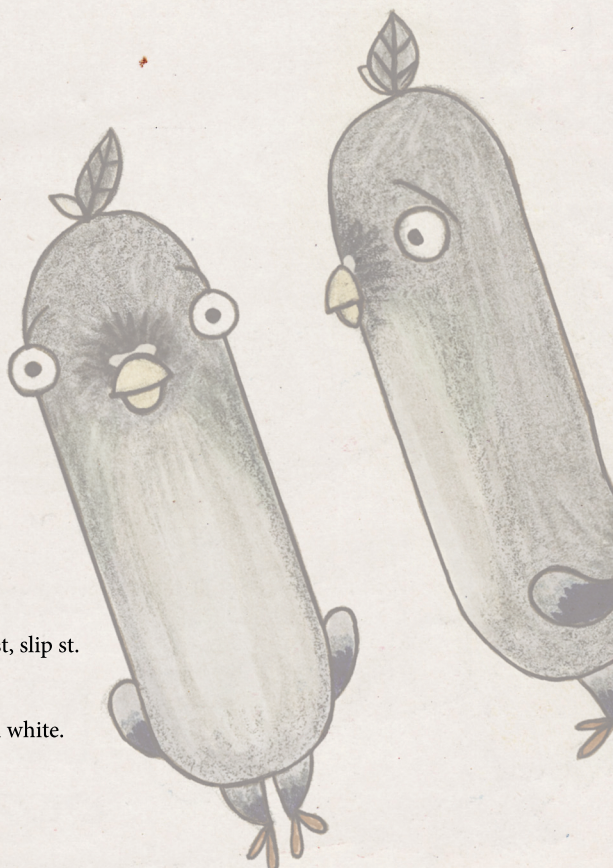
### Body (blue-gray)

- > Chain 2
- 1st round: Work 6 sc in the 2nd ch.
- 2nd round: Work 2 sc in each st of the previous round (= 12 st).
- 3rd round: \* 1 sc in the next st, 2 sc in following st, repeat from \* around (= 18 st).
- 4th round: \* 1 sc each in the next 2 st, 2 sc in the following st, repeat from \* around (= 24 st).
- 5th round: \* 1 sc each in the next 3 st, 2 sc in the following st, repeat from \* around (= 30 st).
- 6th round: \* 1 sc each in the next 4 st, 2 sc in the next st, repeat from \* around (= 36 st).
- 7th - 44th rnds: \* 1 sc in each st of the previous round.
- 45th round: \* 1 sc each in the next 4 st, decrease over 2 sc, repeat from \* around (= 30 st).
- 46th round: \* 1 sc each in the next 3 st, decrease over 2 sc, repeat from \* around (= 24 st).
- 47th round: \* 1 sc each in the next 2 st, decrease over 2 sc, repeat from \* around (= 18 st).
- 48th round: \* 1 sc each in each st of the previous round.
- > Stuff the body.
- 49th round: \* 1 sc each in the next st, decrease over 2 sc, repeat from \* around (= 12 st).
- 50th round: \* 1 st invisible decrease, 1 sc in the next st, repeat from \* around (= 6 st).
- > Cut and tie the threads.

### BEAK (mustard yellow)

Chain 6, 1 sc in the 2nd ch, 3 hdc, 1 sc, 1 slip st.  
Continue on the other side of the ch chain:  
1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 slip st.  
And then on the other side: 1 sc each in every 2nd st, slip st.

- > Cut and tie the threads.
- > Sew the beak on and embroider the upper side with white.
- > Sew the eyes onto the head.





## FEATHERS (blue-gray)

Large: Chain 9.  
1 sc in the 2nd ch, 1 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 slip st.  
Continue on the underside: crochet as described above and end with 1 slip st.

Small: Chain 7  
1 sc in the 2nd ch, 3 hdc, 1 ch, 1 slip st  
Do the same on the underside and end with a slip stitch.

- > Sew the feathers onto the head.

## WINGS 2X (midnight blue)

Chain 13, 1 sc in the 2nd ch,  
1 hdc, 1 dc, 3 trebles, 1 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc, 1 slip st  
Work back on the underside with the same pattern and end with a slip st.

- > Pull both wings into shape and sew them onto the body.

## TAIL FEATHERS (blue-gray)

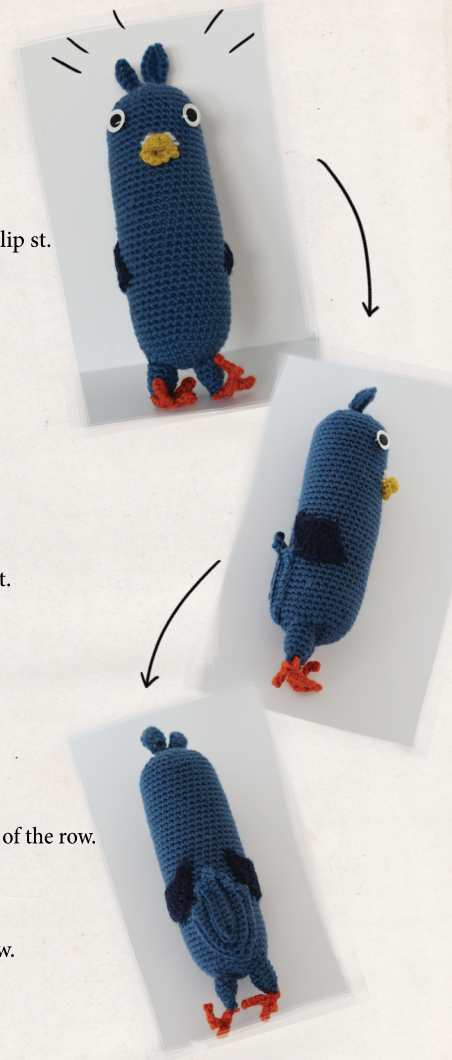
Chain 12 ch and 3 st for the turn.  
1 sc each in every ch of the previous row, 3 sc in the last ch.  
Continue on the underside with 1 sc each in every ch until 2 st from the end of the row.  
Turn with 2 ch and then sc in back loop.  
3 sc in the middle sc of the 3 sc in the previous row.  
Continue to 2 st from the end of the row. Turn with 2 ch.  
Continue until the tail is large enough. End 2 st before the end of the row.

- > Sew the tail feathers on.

## LEGS 2X (blue-gray, pumpkin)

Chain 2. 3 sc in the 1st ch, close the 3 st with a slip st making a loop.  
Next round: 2 sc in each st (= 6 st).  
Next round: \* 1 sc, then 2 sc in 1 st,  
repeat from \* around (= 9 st).  
Slip st, 3 rounds chain stitch.  
Tie threads and begin the foot with 1 slip st (in orange) on the end of the leg.  
5 ch, crochet around the ch with 4 sc, 1 slip st in the middle of the foot.  
4 ch, crochet around the ch with 3 sc, 1 slip st in the middle of the foot.  
5 ch, crochet around the ch with 4 sc, 1 slip st in the middle of the foot, tie the threads.

- > Stuff the legs and sew them onto the body.
